## School-Based Services

Aspire Indiana is non-profit comprehensive community mental health center serving children and adults in Marion, Boone, Hamilton, and Madison Counties in Central Indiana.

School-Based Services are those counseling services provided at a school facility. We treat children of all ages whose behavior and functioning has been impaired by a variety of symptoms associated with ADHD, anxiety, adjustment to trauma and loss, behavioral problems, depression, substance use, and thought disorders, as well as other issues. School-Based Services may include one or more of the following services:

- Individual Therapy
- Family Therapy
- Individual & Group Skills Training
- Case Coordination
- Psychological Assessment
- Medication Management

If you are interested in services for your child, please contact Aspire's Access department at 1-877-574-1254 to create an account. You will need to provide your child's name, insurance information, and other basic demographic information. Please let them know that services will be school-based and identify the district and school your child attends.

Once an account is created, the therapist will be notified and will then contact you to schedule an intake assessment. This initial appointment will be at school and typically takes about two hours. When you come for the intake assessment, you will need to bring your driver's license/photo ID and your child's insurance card. Only legal guardians may consent to treatment. If you are not the child's biological parent, you will need to provide proof of legal guardianship.
