 - He's the Almighty
 - He's the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords.
 - He's the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and End, the First and the Last
 - He's the Great Champion Warrior that overcame the world.
 - He's the rider of the white horse that conquers the nations and judges them by his righteous hand.
