

## Omega: Revelation 1:4-8

### Jesus Loves Us

1 John 4:19 - We love because He first loved us.

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world that He gave his only Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

- How has God's love for you changed your life?

Since love is communicated through action...

- How are we loving others?
- What keeps us from loving others?

### He has freed us from our sin

Romans 6:23; Ephesians 1:7; Isaiah 53:5

Freedom comes through forgiveness

- In what ways has forgiveness created freedom in your life?

Romans 6: 17-18

- What do you think it means to be a slave to righteousness?

### He made us a kingdom and priests

- Do we treat Jesus as king of our lives? Why or why not?

As priests we serve to worship the King and we are also communicators of the Good News.

- How are you serving Him?
- How are you worshiping Him?
- How are you sharing the Good News with others?

What have you done with what Jesus did?

- Does your life actually look like your in the Kingdom of God submitted to Jesus as King or does your life look like your kingdom is still of this world?
- Does your life... your actions... your mouth... your words attest to the dominion of Christ, or to your flesh?
  
- Are you forgiving as Jesus commands?
- Are you putting away the works of flesh like Jesus commands?
- Are you generously giving while being led by the Spirit with a cheerful heart?
- Are you not forsaking the assembling of yourselves as Jesus commands?
  
- Is Jesus the Lord of your bank account?
- Is Jesus the Lord of your mouth?
- Is Jesus the Lord of your marriage?
- Is Jesus the Lord of your children's ambitions?
- Is Jesus the Lord of your Sabbath?
- Is Jesus the Lord of your internet usage?
- Is Jesus the Lord of your work ethic?
  
- Are you living like a priest in the Kingdom of God?
- Are you serving others and preaching the Gospel?
- Does your life scream glory to God!?
- Does your life look like a consistent pattern of worshipping and helping others worship?

Or, could someone point at your life... not the one on Sunday where you get all dressed up spiritually, but the complete picture... could they honestly answer that you live in the Kingdom of God or the Kingdom of this world.

If you are not confident in your salvation, if you don't know which Kingdom you are in... call upon the name of the Lord and you will be saved!
