Toil- The Grind and Discipline

Patient Endurance- Focused on the finish line and not giving up

- What are some reasons why we quit?
- This church saw what God values and didn't quit pressing into that. Does our focus on the goal help us endure to the end? Why or why not?
- Do you want to remain faithful to the Lord through hard times? Don't quit!!

Sensitive to Sin and False doctrine- Responsible to truth and holiness and rejecting sin

- What do you do when you hear something that challenges your faith?
- Do we rely on others to protect us or do we seek to protect ourselves?

What Jesus doesn't find valuable: Revelation 2:4 Ephesians 1:15-16 1Corinthians 13:1-3

You abandoned the love you had at first-

- Have you abandoned your love for the Lord?
- We know love is more than a feeling it is an action, so why are these works above not enough?
- Their affection had cooled and they had lost focus on loving the Lord. 1Corinthians 13:3 explains this well.

How should we respond:

Remember- Remember when you started drifting from the Lord. Pray about it, recognize who you are, who He is.

Repent- Turn from where you are going and go back to where you fell.

Redo- Do those things that you did when your love was on fire for the Lord.
