SART Meeting, December 3, 2020

This month's meeting was held via Zoom. Dr. Rodrigues from WVU's LGBTQ+ Center attended to provide a SafeZone training to our team. This training covered terms related to the LGBTQ community, including orientation, expression, identity. We discussed a variety of issues faced by the LGBTQ+ community, including biphobia/bi-erasure, examples of institutional exclusions for non-binary and trans individuals, and limited legal protections. We also discussed how to provide more inclusive services, providing direct advocacy for LGBTQ+ individuals by interrupting bias when we see it, and providing pronouns when introducing ourselves as a way of providing a safe and welcoming space.
