

"BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BROOKWOOD, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:"

SECTION A. Any person driving a vehicle on a street or highway within the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood, shall drive the same at a careful and prudent speed not greater than is reasonable and proper, having due regard to the traffic, surface and width of the highway and of any other conditions then existing and no person shall drive any vehicle upon a highway at such a speed as to endanger the life, limb or property of any person.

SECTION B. The following speed limits are hereby specifically set and made applicable to that portion of Alabama Highway No. 216 running through the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood, and also to that portion of Tuscaloosa County Road No. 59 running within the Town of Brookwood;

(1) The speed limit on Alabama Highway 216 shall be Forty-five (45) mph for that portion of said highway running through and within the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood, Alabama:

LESS AND EXCEPT THAT CERTAIN PORTION OF SAID HIGHWAY DESIGNATED AS A SCHOOL ZONE BY THE ALABAMA HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND BETTER DESCRIBED AS THE PORTION OF THAT HIGHWAY RUNNING ADJACENT TO AND IN FRONT OF BROOKWOOD HIGH SCHOOL AND BROOKWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. THE SPEED ON THAT SAID HIGHWAY SHALL BE TWENTY-FIVE (25) MPH DURING THAT PORTION OF ANY DAY IN WHICH STUDENTS ARE TRAVELING TO OR FROM SCHOOL.

(2) The speed limit shall be Forty-five (45) mph on that portion of Tuscaloosa County Road No. 59 running in and through the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood, Alabama.

SECTION C. Said speed limits shall be duly posted by authority of the Town Council of the Town of Brookwood, Alabama, in accordance with all local and state law, and in cooperation with the Alabama Highway Department.

SECTION D. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance. Every person convicted for any violation of any of the provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine or not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than Ten (10) days; for a second such conviction within one year thereafter such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 20 days or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within one year after the first conviction such person shall be punished by fine or not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
