

ORDINANCE NO. 82-O-107

"BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BROOKWOOD, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:"

SECTION A. The speed limits heretofore made applicable to that portion of Alabama Highway 216 running through the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood and also that portion of Tuscaloosa County Road Number 59 running within the Town of Brookwood by Ordinance No. 78-104 is hereby repealed and the speed limits for the said roads are changed as hereinafter set out.

SECTION B. The speed limit of Alabama Highway 216 shall be 45 miles per hour for that portion of the said highway lying between the 9.7 mile mark and the 10.9 mile mark, and between the 11.9 mile mark and the 12.5 mile mark. The speed limit of Alabama Highway 216 shall be 35 miles per hour for that portion of said highway lying between the 10.9 mile mark and the 11.9 mile mark.

SECTION C. The speed limit on Alabama Highway 216 for that certain portion of said highway designated as a school zone by the Alabama Highway Department and better described as the portion of that highway running adjacent to and in front of Brookwood High School and Brookwood Elementary School shall be 25 miles per hour during that portion of any day in which students are traveling to or from school.

SECTION D. The speed limit on Tuscaloosa County Highway 59 shall be 35 miles per hour for that portion lying between the intersection of Tuscaloosa County Road 59 with Alabama Highway 216 to the .8 mile marker on Tuscaloosa County Road 59. The speed limit on said County Road shall be 45 miles per hour for that portion of said road lying between the .8 mile mark and to the 2.8 mile mark.

SECTION E. Said speed limits shall be posted by authority of the Town Council of the Town of Brookwood, Alabama in accordance with all local and state law, and in cooperation with the Alabama Highway Department, all of said portions of road lying in the corporate limits of the Town of Brookwood or within the police jurisdiction of the Town of Brookwood.

SECTION F: It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance. Every person convicted for any violation of any of the provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than Ten (10) days; for a second such conviction within one year thereafter such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 20 days or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a third or subsequent conviction within one year after the first conviction such person shall be punished by fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
